## League Season

Start times are Thursday, May 21st. Each team will play a minimum of 13 matches. There is a maximum of 36-2 man teams. We will run the league from May 21st to August 13th. We are attempting to assist the farmer's in getting their crops in that still want to play and to help on the football season on the other end. We will start at 5:30 each Thursday. Entry fee is \$40.00 per team. Greens fee and cart fees extra, season passes honored.

## Handicaps

New players must turn in a minimum of three (3) witnessed 9-hole rounds by May 18th. You may also use the nights of April 30, May 8 and 15 to get your scores in if you cannot play at other times. If this is not completed the player starts with a ZERO handicap. Give your cards to the Pro Shop staff.

Handicaps are revised on a weekly basis and are based on the Golf League Championship Rules. Maximum individual handicap is 18 for 9 holes. Maximum carded score is a triple bogey on any hole.

## Scoring

Teams listed first on the schedule score the match. Both teams should sign the scorecard. Turn the cards into the Pro Shop each night.

### **A total of 27 points are up for grabs during each competition.**

Match-Player Points: the player with the lowest handicap is matched against the player on the other team with the lowest handicap for individual hole competition (A players). They play off their handicap between them (i.e. if a 9 handicap golfer plays a 5 handicap golfer, the 9 handicap golfer receives 4 handicap strokes and the 5 receives 0 handicap strokes. B players play and are paired in the same way. Handicaps are applied on a hole-by-hole basis with the lowest handicap (most difficult hole first).

Each player's individual match will be worth one point per hole, making a total of 9 possible points in an individual match (18 points for the two matches). A player's net score on a hole is matched against the competing player's net score, and the player with the lower net score gets a point for that hole. If there is tie on the hole, each player receives 1/2 point.

Stroke-Player & Team Points:

Player-again, the A players play against each other, B players against each other. This is an Individual net-score competition. Three (3) points are available for each match, total of 6 points for the match. Ties are split.

Team-Adding both player's total 9-hole scores and subtracting the total handicap (combined handicap of each player) will generate a team score. The team with the lowest net total wins 3 points. Ties are split, 1.5 points each team.

Individual Match Play -	A Match	- 9 points
	B Match	- 9 points
	Stroke (low 9-hole net score)	- 6 points (3 each match)
	Team Stroke Play	- 3 points

### Rain Outs

If the course is closed, two weeks are recommended to make-up the match. If the weather is questionable, the decision is at the discretion of the the teams. Two weeks are again recommended for the make-up.

Matches not reconciled by the end of the season will be scored "0" for both teams. No Make-ups after July 31 for dates earlier in the season. Always assume you are playing unless you contact your opponent.

### Local and League Rules

Roll the ball in your fairway only. Play the ball as it lies in all other situations. If you ball lies on bare dirt, you may pick, clean and place the ball, no penalty, one club length no closer to the hole. This will be self-policing and your cooperation will be appreciated.

Short putts may be given to your opponent at your discretion. Avoid slow play-keep the league moving.

Note: schedules will not be mailed. They will be given out at the Pro Shop or on-line ([www.g3golf.com](http://www.g3golf.com)) not later than May 15th.

You may will have a link for you to view the results each week on-line. Also we will still have the league corner by our main office.

We may adjust the schedule depending on the number of team entered. You DO NOT need to be a member to play in our league. This is to encourage more players to try our fine, new facility.
